

## DERWENT VALLEY TOURS LTD – PICK-UP POINTS

Our Derwent Valley Tours start their journey through the incredible [Derwent Valley Mills World Heritage Site](#) from Matlock in the northern end of the Valley and from Derby in the south. There is only one start point for each tour, and you should ensure that you choose a date where the pick-up location suits you.

### MATLOCK:



The pick-up for tours starting in Matlock will be outside the Rail and Bus Station Interchange, DE4 3NA. You are responsible for organising your own car-parking.

Make your way to the Rail and Bus Station Interchange and wait by the bus loading bays, where the minibus will be waiting at 9.45am.

Please make yourself known to the Tour Manager, who carries a board with the DVT logo, or find the minibus, which displays the logo as well. Please be punctual and look out for the bus. If you have any problems, give us a call and we will advise you.

The tour will also finish at this location. If you wish to be dropped off at a location en route, please discuss this with the minibus driver and Tour Manager during the day to ensure this is acceptable.

The pickup for tours starting in Derby will be by the Bonnie Prince Charlie statue on Cathedral Green, off Full Street, DE1 3AF. You are responsible for organising your own car-parking.

Make your way to the Bonnie Prince Charlie statue on Cathedral Green, Full Street, where the minibus will be waiting at 9.30am.
